Continuing Education Credit / Contact Hours

Continuing education credit/contact hours for school nurses may be earned in some states, but not all.

School Nurse CEUs Offered

The following states <u>DO</u> require continuing education units for <u>RNs/LPNs</u> to maintain their certification/licenses. Each of these states has told us they will accept BER/IED's approval by the California Board of Registered Nursing as a Continuing Education Provider.

Certificate of Participation

The Certificate of Participation will include the following statement, including the specific number of CEUs/Contact hours for each course, in all of the above states:

Provider approved by the California Board of Registered Nursing,
Provider #CEP 15144, for ___ CEUs/Contact hours for RNs and LPNs.
The participant shall maintain the certificate of completion for a period of four (4) years after the course concludes.

APRNs need to check with their credentialing agency to determine if this course meets the additional CEU requirements for their specialty area.

School Nurse CEUs Not Offered

The following states <u>DO</u> require continuing education units for <u>RNs/LPNs</u> to maintain their certification/licenses, but <u>DO</u> <u>NOT</u> accept our approval by the California Board of Registered Nursing as a Continuing Education Provider. Therefore, participants attending our school nurse courses cannot receive CE/contact hours specific to nursing to apply toward maintaining their certification/license. *Participants may still receive general teaching continuing education units for these states with prior district approval.*
